THE SAGE OF GANESHPURI

According to the legend, in Tunehi village of Kerla a newborn was found on a stormy night by laborer, Chatu Nair, A cobra with its hood raised, stood guarding over it. Nair brought to child to his employer, a local advocate, Ishwar Ayyar and together they brought up the child and name him Raman.

Even during very early age people knew he was no ordinary child and witnessed miracles around him. As Ishwar Ayyar approached his last days, he requested Raman to grant him darshan of Lord Surya Narayan. When Ayyar experienced the event, he was overwhelmed and said to Raman **"You have granted the supreme bliss, hence you are my Nityanad"** Nityanand the young man now, took a yoga, austerities and penance. He travelled to the Himalaya, Varanasi, Colombo, Rameswaram, Udipi, Mangalore...... etc. Wherever he went people were freed illness, sorrow and poverty through divine healings. By the time Shree Nityanand reached Kanhangad, his fame had spread far and wide attracting countless devotees.

At Kanhangad and nearby Guruvan, he established a settlement of caves for habitation and meditation. He also planted trees and materialized a stream, later named Papnashini Ganga which still glows today.

The final stage of his journey brought him to Mumbai where people witnessed healing and miracles. In 1937, He proceeded to the Tansa valley to Akloli and Vajreshwari, where he established schools, rest houses, clinics and renovated the temples and continued his preaching, with emphasis on meditation.

Shortly thereafter he come to nearby **Ganeshpuri** and settled their near the ancient Shree Bhimeshwar Mahadev Temple. Thousands of visitors from the nearby villages and faraway placed flocked to this new abode, which has gradually developed into a powerful **center of pilgrimage** as stands today, for people coming in search of spiritual material upliftment.

BABA'S MESSAGE

By the large, Baba's presence, itself was the medium of communication. In his powerful aura, people, would fall silent. Those who had question would have them answered without asking and doubts would be laid to rest without discussion. People would forget their stress and worries as they soaked in the peace and contentment in presence of the great Avadhoot. **Noble silence was the message**.

Miracles and divine experiences have touched numerous devotees who have approached him. Bhagwan Nityanand took Mahasamadhi on 8th August 1961. His shrine at Ganeshpuri is a testimony of his divine presence where his countless devotees find solace and experience his kindness even today.

BALBHOJAN

The Balbhojan is the manifestation of Baba's unbounded love and compassion for children, which resulted in concern and plans for the development and welfare of the children, especially the poor and the Adivasi children. These included providing nourishing



meals, clothing, primary education, shelter, health care and most important character building. By so doing, baba was setting an example to society and the Balbhojan was a symbol of Baba's greater vision for the future. On as average 250 children, 1000 adults and Sadhus are fed daily.

HOT WATER KUND

The hot water springs adjacent to the Samadhi Mandir and Shiva Temple are blessed by Bhagwan Nityanand. Legend has it that during the Yagna conducted by Maharshi Vashistha (and presided over by the Deities), these spring curative powers



were created for the comfort of the honored guests.

It is beyond doubt that the place possesses its share of divinity, apart from Baba's presence, there are reported ethereal sightings (Sapta Rishis) and celestial music.

SHREE BHIMESHWAR MAHADEVMANDIR

Right in front of Kund and adjacent to Baba's Samadhi Mandir, is the very ancient temple of Shree Bhimeshwar Mahadev. This spot was utterly desolate with very few pilgrims, until Baba came in 1937 and settled next to this temple. Later



Baba shifted his residence to his Ashram called "Vaikuntha". Soon, the Bhimeshwar Shiva

Temple & Vaikuntha Ashram became powerful center of pilgrimage. Often water from the temple ceiling would mysteriously drip on the floor and would form into mini Shiva Linga.

BHADRAKALI MANDIR

The temple of Devi Bhadrakali was conceived by Baba as per the wish of Devi herself and was first set up in the form of an alter in Baba's Ashram. The temple came up in due course.

GOPAL KRISHNA MANDIR

The Gopal Krishna Mandir was earlier housing a stone image of Nandi. During construction the statue of Nandi had to be shifted, but could not be done even by fifteen people. Baba advised to break a coconut and the task was accomplished easily.

Baba himself consecrated the idol of Lord Shri Krishna and the stone Nandi was modified into Krishna's cow.



Daily Puja and Krishna Janmashtami are being performed and celebrated faithfully and regularly.

NAVGRAHA SHRINE

Heeding to the aspirations of many devotees visiting Baba's Samadhi, the Trustees set up a shrine for the worship of Navgraha, flanking the eastern front of the Samadhi Mandir.



VAJRESHWARI

About 3 Kms. from Ganeshpuri, the famous temple of Vajreshwari Devi, a seat of powerful shakti attracts devotees, from far & wide.



Ganeshpuri is an ancient place and resort famous for its natural beauty. Overlooking the valley is mount Mandakini, where Siddhas have performed austerities. The river Tansa lovely and purifying flows through the valley. There are many hot springs around the place. They are said to be the gifts of sage Vashishtha, who created them by his divine power for the use and comfort of the many sages who used to collect in that place for the Yadhnya.

Ages ago, the sage Vashishtha performed a large "Yadhnya" here a fire ceremony. At that time, according to tradition, Vashishtha installed an image of lord Ganesh in a temple of Bhimeshwar Mahadev and since that time this land came to be known as Ganeshpuri. In front of the ancient temple of Bhimeshwar Mahadev, Gurudev got three hot spring tanks dug. Gurudev is reported to have impressed upon many of his devotees that the hot springs were very sacred and what is known as "Brahma Muhurta" many divine Siddhas come for a bath in them. Anybody coming to Swamiji's Darshan was first ask to take a bath in these "Kunda's" i.e. Hot springs, by the Swamiji, Devotees experience that many of their diseases vanished after taking holy dip into these "Kunda's"

And so this spiritually - charged landscape, once a wish - fulfilling place for devotees of long ago, was brought to life again by Gurudev. He come and stayed and made it immortal. Shree Gurudev Nityanand changed the look of Ganeshpuri completely. Once deserted, it has become a paradise.






